

Erasmus+ and ESK Info-sheet: Formulating Impact

Step 1: Formulate the impact of the project for your general objective(s)!

Step 2: Formulate the impact of the project for your specific, subordinate objectives!

Step 3: Elaborate the effects in the impact levels for each general and specific objective!

Step 4: Develop impact indicators and show how you will check and monitor the impact.

Example: mobility project of learners and professionals

Impact level	Specific objective:	Indicators
Local	Draw attention to operation	Reports in local newspapers
Regional	Be an impulse / role model for training companies in the region	Number of conversations to exchange experiences
National	Participation in national championship	Number of Participants
International	Participation in international championship	Number of Participants
Organisation	Intercultural learning through international exchange of skilled workers	Number of professionals participating
Employees	International further training opportunities	Number of further training courses
Apprentices / Participants	Expansion of language skills and specialised knowledge	Increase in competence levels
Personal	International and intercultural learning	Exchange with colleagues
Systemic	Vocational school integrates exchange into school system	Change in curriculum
